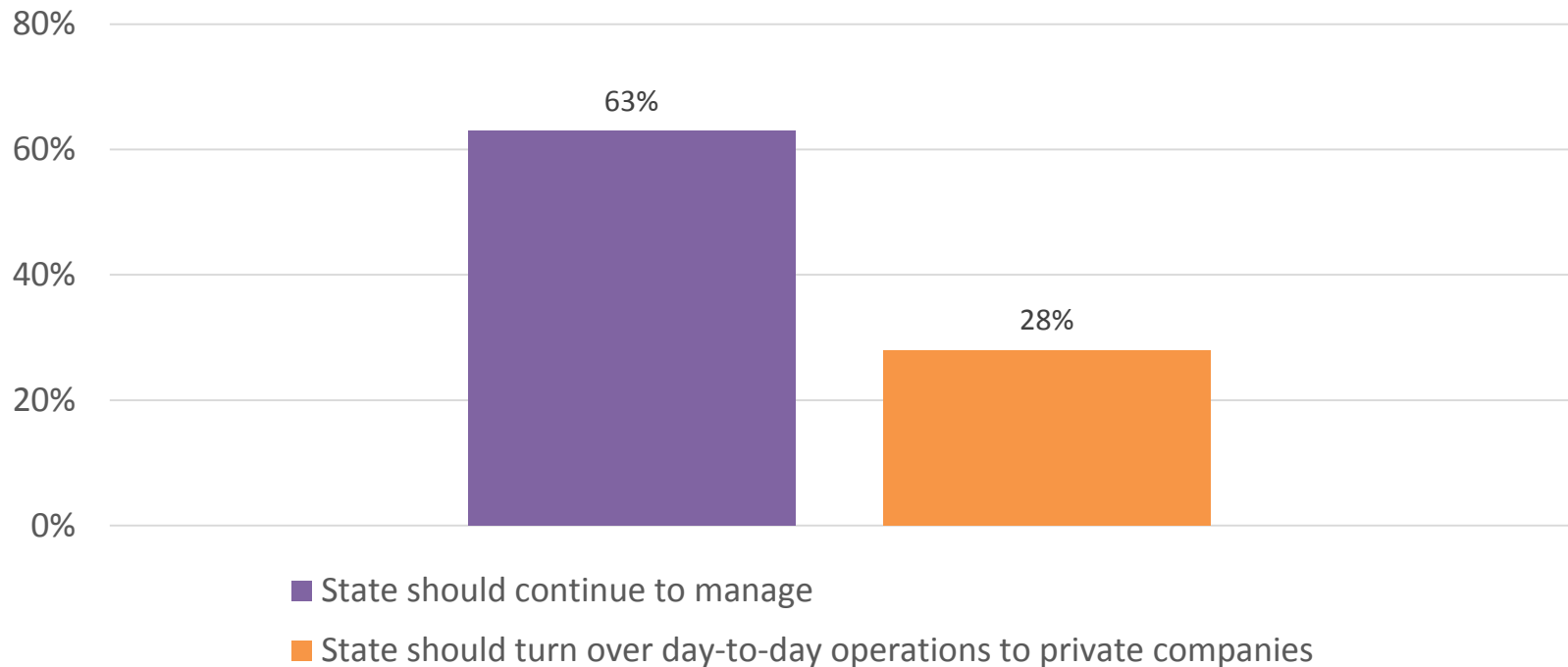


Views on Privatization of State Services
