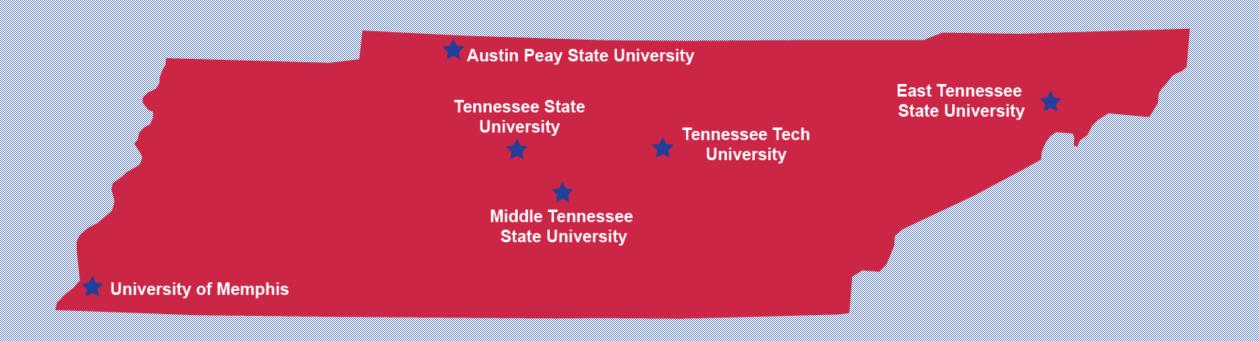

Impact of LGIs on Tennessee

Total LGI Enrollment

- 83,461 (60% of University Total)
- Graduates Produced Annually
 - 19,264 (60% of University Total)
- Total Economic Impact of LGIs
 - Est. > \$8 Billion Annually
- ROI to TN Taxpayers
 - ~\$10 of economic impact to every \$1 of state funding
- Annual Research Expenditures
 - \$159 Million
 - 5 of 6 LGIs are Nationally Ranked Research Universities
 - Rural Health, Telemedicine, Cybersecurity, Roads and Bridges, Electric Vehicles, Opioid Addiction, Gambling Addiction, Rural Business Development, Veterans Counseling, Medicinal Chemistry, Water Quality, Supply Chain, etc.

LGI Requests for Consideration

Operating Budgets

- Predictability!
- THEC Recommendation for LGIs (<u>\$7.5 million</u> Rewards Outcomes and Provides Predictability)
- Inflation
- Salary Pool (State Funds 55% of 3% Raise Pool)
- Unfunded Mandates (\$15.8 million/yr Tuition Discounts for Teachers, State Employees, etc.)
- Capital Budgets
 - Predictability!
 - One New Capital Outlay Project Appears in Governor's Proposed Budget
 - Capital Maintenance Appropriation Needed to Simply "Tread Water" (<u>\$90 million/yr</u>)
 - Appropriation Needed to Eliminate Deferred Maintenance Over 10 Years (\$140 million/yr)
 - Maintenance Costs Increase 10-15% Every Year
 - Campus Safety
